

A VISIT TO: MAITREE PARIWAAR SANSTHA

(A REGISTERED GOVT. ORGANIZATION)

Group-II went to a registered governmental organization named as Maitree Pariwaar Sanstha which is majorly operated from Nagpur and is working across India by branching system of the organization.

The organization has two different working paths, the first takes educational care of the children from age 11 to 16 at Maitree Hostel and the second one takes needy care and provisions to the adopted villages including Naxalite area majorly in the patch of Gadchiroli. The sub-branches are widely spread in major city of India i.e. Pune, Mumbai, Nagpur and few essential resourceful and needy towns as Gadchiroli.

The manager of the Sanstha took us to the huge storing space of every single item that comes out there for donation which includes everything right from newly brought stuff from market (unused) to the kitchen utensil, school bags (to get repaired), clothes (used and unused), books etc. There are different ways to segregate and give it to both the ways mentioned above.

For the students at the hostel, they do not give them the donated cloths rather they purchase new ones for them. On the other lines, these donated cloths are given to the people living in adopted villages by the Sanstha. The organization members set-up the donation camps at all the villages taking help from their entire team members and give the clothes with respect to their respective sizes.



While the cloths are stored in the huge go-down, they are segregated in varied stacks, one could be for heavy dresses, one for casual wears, these both would be further segregated for male, female and kids. The books stored would be then differentiated in notebooks, text books, reading books (for library), pages and recycled material as well.

After all of these procedures, the sanstha keeps on finding the one who cannot afford to buy the books, so according to his needs, the books would be given to him for his studies and likewise the care is taken in educational sector as well. For the rest of the material, some is given to the paper industries to recycle and make a new one out of it and whatever money comes from it is then again used for the development of the organization. And it keeps on going.
