Competition Brief & Rules

'Creative' Name Plates

To design and make a 'Creative' Name plate for your own home to be fixed on the main door of your house. The nameplate shall be of optimum size conveying sufficient information about the owner/occupants. Homemade / Do it yourself models of name plates shall be given preferences. Participant may use materials and colour scheme of his/her choice as per design.

'Eco-Friendly' Ganesha

To design, decorate and celebrate an 'Eco-Friendly' Ganesha at your own home. Homemade / Do it yourself idols and environment friendly decoration and themes shall be given preferences. Participant may use materials and colour scheme of his/her choice as per design. There shall be no restriction for the scale and size of the Ganesha idol and decoration.

'Innovative' Lantern

To design an 'Innovative' Lantern for festivals at your home. Homemade / Do it yourself models and environment friendly materials and themes shall be given preferences. Participant may use materials and colour scheme of his/her choice as per design. The lantern shall be purely for decorative purpose. Participant may design provision for housing lighting, etc within the lantern. There shall be no restriction for the scale and size of the lantern.

Who can participate?

- Participation in above Competitions is open to students studying in class 5'th to class 7'th (5'st Std. to 7'th Std.) from selected Schools in Nagpur and other Indian cities.
- A registration form will be available where the participants' data will be requested and the competition entry should be submitted.
- Participants are required to fill in the information about his/her school along with a School Identity card confirming it along with the entry submission.
